

### **PREFACE**

Child Help Foundation (CHF) is a pan-India non-profit organization dedicated to empowering marginalized and underprivileged communities, with a primary focus on children's well-being, health, and education. Over the past 13 years, CHF has worked relentlessly across India, delivering humanitarian aid and support to those in need.

Since its inception, CHF has taken significant strides in addressing the most pressing challenges faced by vulnerable children and families. By offering healthcare support, nutrition, and educational opportunities, the foundation ensures a holistic approach to child development. This comprehensive methodology has enabled CHF to make substantial progress in uplifting the quality of life for children and their families, thereby contributing to the overall betterment of society.

One of CHF's notable achievements has been in the field of education, particularly in its efforts to make quality education accessible to underprivileged children in remote areas. The foundation has established several Mini Science Centres (MSCs) in Ashram Schools in the Palghar district of Maharashtra, providing students with an opportunity to explore hands-on learning in science and mathematics. These MSCs are equipped with models and tools that make learning engaging and interactive, fostering an interest in STEM fields among the students. By emphasizing experiential learning, CHF aims to cultivate critical thinking and problem-solving skills in young minds, preparing them for the challenges of tomorrow.

In addition to its work in Maharashtra, CHF has expanded its educational initiatives to other regions. The organization has set up **computer labs** in schools such as the

Central Primary School (Marathi Medium) in Amboli, Dadra and Nagar Haveli, and Tailika Balika Vidyalaya in Barbigha, Bihar. These labs are fully equipped with modern computers and software, giving students access to digital education and bridging the digital divide.

Beyond education, CHF is deeply committed to safeguarding the health and well-being of children. The foundation conducts free health screenings for students across its network of schools, focusing on early detection of physical ailments and providing timely medical interventions. By identifying potential health issues at an early stage, CHF ensures that children receive the care they need, preventing illnesses from interfering with their education and personal growth.

Furthermore, CHF has made significant contributions to enhancing the quality of life for entire communities. Through its health camps, awareness programs, and nutrition initiatives, the foundation addresses broader issues affecting children and their families, ensuring that they receive the support they need to lead dignified lives.

Over the years, Child Help Foundation has positively impacted the lives of **48,45,101** people across India through its wideranging programs. The foundation's work is driven by a deep sense of responsibility toward society and a belief that every child, regardless of their background, deserves the opportunity to realize their full potential.

The organization's efforts have not only improved the lives of countless children but also fostered a sense of hope and resilience in the communities it serves. Through its ongoing commitment to making a difference, Child Help Foundation continues to be a beacon of hope for underprivileged children and families across India.



### **Enriching Minds, Providing Care**



A child cannot focus on their academic endeavours if they are not healthy. Lifethreatening diseases like **cancer**, **thalassemia and heart disease** are huge obstacles in a child's education. A child who does not know how to take care of their health, are more vulnerable to contracting deadly diseases.

The dilemma proves that education and health need to go hand-in-hand for the creation of a robust nation and society. Child Help Foundation conducts **health screening** for students in Ashram Schools, called **School Health Programme**. Under the School Health Programme, students are screened to examine their nutritional status and identify potential illnesses, infections and medical conditions.

Additionally, we have also set up Mini Science Centers in the Palghar district of Maharashtra to offer interactive scientific learning. In these centres, children are given hands-on learning experience of scientific lessons through models, demonstrations and experiments. **Computer labs** have also been set up at Central Primary School (Marathi Medium) in Amboli, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu and Tailika Balika Vidyalaya in Barbigha, Bihar to empower children with digital education.

Throughout the financial year 2023–2024, Child Help Foundation has saved the lives of **469** children from terminal illnesses and provided education to **10,931** students. Furthermore, **61,874** mothers were provided a space to feed their children and **85,486** people were educated about health with our health-related programmes.


In the next financial year, we hope to improve our prospects and help more children.

## FROM THE DESK OF THE EXECUTIVE



Children are beaming with untapped potential, and investing in them can change our nation for the better. When a child gets educated, he uplifts his family and nation along with him. Yet, poverty and illness go hand in hand, and a child's education can come to a sudden halt in an instant due to critical illness. These illnesses destroy years of progress that children have worked hard for, and it is during this time that they need our help

Throughout the year 2023-24, we have done our best to provide for as many children as possible. We hope to increase this number, in the coming years, and also to work in new ventures.

In the financial year 2023-24, our team of donors, volunteers and workforce worked selflessly to fulfil our goals and mission. Our 'Good Health and Well-Being' programme has saved **469** children from terminal medical illnesses, provided **61,874** mothers with safe

spaces and educated 85,486 people through health-related programmes. Zero Hunger catered to 6,73,821 people and made sure hunger didn't bother their minds during sleep. 10,931 children were empowered with education in the 'Quality Education' initiative. WAS (Water and Sanitation) helped 16,573 people, which covered menstrual health, toilet construction, installation of water purifiers and other activities. 1,017 lives were saved during disasters and the lives of 20 villagers were made better through our village development scheme. In an effort to make the world a safer place for women, we reached out to 53,251 people.

**2,554** plants and animals were helped through our 'Life on Land' initiative, which included feeding drives and plantation drives and over **928** kgs of garbage were collected from various beaches throughout India, which saved the lives of **27,840** marine species, with the help of our friends at Beach Army.

I am grateful to my team of volunteers, donors and corporate sponsors for working with full zeal and dedication to deliver these numbers. Through their tireless work, they made the impossible possible.

I am hopeful that the future will bring us more opportunities to help more people in the future with our various programmes and initiatives.



Child Help Foundation (CHF) launched the Bazaarhaat Community Development Project last year in Gulabigaon (Bhintghar community), Nashik, Maharashtra. This initiative aims to empower individuals by establishing a business hub with multiple shops, enabling people to start their own businesses and earn a sustainable livelihood. In addition to providing infrastructure, CHF offers training and skill development programs to create more employment opportunities and enhance economic stability. So far, the project has positively impacted 2,167 beneficiaries, fostering self-reliance and community growth in the region.











#### **GOOD HEALTH & WELL-BEING**

#### **Emergency Medical Support**

United Nations' Sustainable Development Goal 3 (SDG 3): Good Health and Well-Being aims to enhance healthcare quality and prevent unnecessary suffering from avoidable diseases and premature death. According to the most recent World Health Organisation report, inadequate healthcare is responsible for between 5.7 and 8.4 million deaths annually in low- and middle-income countries (LMICs), representing up to 15% of all deaths in these regions.

The goal is to increase life expectancy and reduce mortality rates by strengthening primary healthcare systems, focusing on maternal and newborn health, and prioritising mental health.

Child Help Foundation has embraced SDG 3 by making Emergency Medical Support its flagship programme. This initiative provides healthcare services to children aged 0–18, aiming to save as many lives as possible.

We offer financial assistance for treatments such as heart defect surgeries, spine deformities, kidney and liver transplants, stem cell transplants, extended NICU care for newborns, chemotherapy, and other long-term medical needs. Child Help Foundation supports families in accessing these critical treatments. We believe that good health is foundational to progress, including education. Children in good health are better positioned to benefit from education and pursue successful careers.

To date, we have delivered Emergency Medical Support to **3,348** children, and our commitment to bringing smiles through medical assistance continues

#### **Arogya Sadan**

In a city, as expensive as Mumbai, the harsh reality is that most underprivileged families simply cannot afford the financial burden of travel and accommodation. This is where Arogya Sadan comes in and extends a compassionate hand to underprivileged families from remote regions of India to stay and travel to and fro from Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital and Medical Research Institute to their designated residential premises in Borivali for Thalassaemic major pediatric patients and their families.

Arogya Sadan not only provides lodging premises for patients in Mumbai but also for their family members and their donors. The lodging also offers services like unwavering support staff 24/7, a doctor's prescribed diet, tuition classes and recreational activities. The project also extends post-transplant care for the patients, along with their donors, because they deserve nothing less than the best.

Aarav Kumar, the first patient of Arogya Sadan, successfully underwent BMT treatment to fight life-threatening thalassemia, He has been recently discharged from Kokilaben Hospital and currently resides in Arogya Sadan to complete his observation period.

Arogya Sadan is a life-saving option for children who live in remote areas and cannot access healthcare facilities. Through Arogya Sadan, patients and their families can travel to Mumbai without worrying about caring about day-to-day expenses.



#### 1. Mohammad Arsh, 10 Years Heart Disease

Mohammad Arsh, a young boy, often felt exhausted, and his lips turned blue due to his severe heart disease. His family, consisting of five members, struggled financially, with his father being the sole breadwinner working as a carpenter. Desperate for help, Arsh's father turned to Child Help Foundation for assistance. After conducting the necessary verifications, CHF worked with generous donors to raise funds for Arsh's treatment. Thanks to the support, Arsh received the medical care he needed, giving him a chance for a healthier, brighter future. Child Help Foundation's intervention made a life-changing difference for the family.





### **2. Soyam Vennela,** 3 Months Complex Heart Disease

Born to Soyam Kishor, a laborer earning a meager Rs. 400 on workdays in Adilabad, Telangana, Soyam Vennela's condition was diagnosed as a complex heart defect requiring urgent surgery. As her health deteriorated, she was admitted to Apollo Institute of Medical Sciences and Research in Hyderabad, where doctors recommended a Mixed TAPVC repair, PFO Open, and management of severe pulmonary hypertension, with an estimated cost of Rs. 6,75,000. Despite their financial constraints, Vennela's parents are determined to get her the life-saving treatment she needs. Thanks to the overwhelming generosity of donors, the necessary funds were raised, allowing Vennela to undergo the crucial surgery.



### **3. Anushka Punia,** 4 Years Heart Disease

Anushka was born with a weak heart, and rest and comfort were foreign to her as she struggled with constant health issues. Her parents, unable to afford the expensive treatment, were left helpless. In their time of need, the donors of Child Help Foundation stepped in, ensuring Anushka received the life-saving treatment she required. Thanks to their generosity, Anushka is now able to rest peacefully for the first time in her life, free from the constant strain of her condition. Child Help Foundation's support has given her a new lease on life, filled with hope and comfort.





### **4. Abhishek Ratheesh,** 9 Years Kidney Complications

Being a single mother, Anju faced immense challenges in providing proper care for her son, Abhishek. With her elderly parents providing the only financial support, Anju felt helpless when it came to affording the necessary treatment for her son's condition. In her desperation, she reached out to Child Help Foundation for assistance. Thanks to the unwavering support of generous donors, Abhishek received the medical care he desperately needed. Thanks to their kindness, the baby received the necessary treatment and was saved, allowing Rinitha and Shaj to experience the joy of a healthy child.





### **6. Veera Davbha,** 5 Months Heart Disease

Veera, just five months old, appeared much younger due to her heart condition, which made it impossible for her to gain weight. Her parents were deeply concerned as her health continued to decline. However, thanks to the generous support of Child Help Foundation's donors, Veera received the medical treatment she desperately needed. Today, she has been healed and is on her way to growing like a healthy child. With her health now restored, Veera has a bright future ahead, filled with the joy of normal growth and development.



### **7. Kunal,** 10 Years Heart Disease




#### 19. Karan Hajare, 9 Years


### **26. Mahananda,** 13 Years Scoliosis




#### **46. Maihir,** 3 Years Hepatoblastoma Pretext IV




### **50. Sanjana Chetpally,** 8 Years Heart Disease


# **52. Suhani,** 9 Years Accidental Injuries


#### **56. Zainab,** 5 Years Hernia

### **58. Sameer,** 1 Year 5 Months Heart Disease



### **60. Bhadra,** 15 Years Scoliosis



# **80. Fidal Dev,** 12 Years Heart Disease



# **104. S. Tharsini,** 2 Years 8 Months Heart Disease



Doctors at Balaji Heart Hospital & Diagnostic Centre in Mumbai, Maharashtra have recommended a VSD Surgical Closure o help her recover and lead a healthy life.

The estimated cost of the surgery is Rs.2,50,000 (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Only), a figure far beyond the reach of Meghana's family. Her father, Bhaiya, works as a labourer, while her mother, Gita, is a housewife. Together, they support their family of four with a modest income that barely covers their daily needs. To save Meghana, they have taken loans and fallen into debt, but it is still not enough.

Meghana deserves a chance to grow up, play, and live without pain. Your support can make all the difference in her life. Let us unite to help this little girl and bring back her radiant smile. Every contribution counts. Help Meghana win her fight and give her the future she deserves.



**16. Aaroosh Shaik,** 4 Years Neuroblastoma

In Tiruvallur, Tamil Nadu stays a four-yearold child named Aaroosh Shaik, who has been diagnosed with Neuroblastoma. It all started when he experienced breathing issues, upon undergoing a test a tumour was detected.

According to the doctors at Tamil Nadu's Apollo Cancer Centre (8km from Chennai Central Station), Aaroosh needs 12 vials of injection Dinutuximab (Anti GD-2) and supportive care after bone marrow transplant, the combined cost of which is Rs.15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakh Only).

Aaroosh's father, Dilver, works as a clerk and is the sole breadwinner in his family of seven. He works as a clerk and lives in a rented house. With his financial resources lacking, Aaroosh was forced to sell his family's jewellery and took some help from his friends but it still wasn't enough.

**17. Leraisha Mary Laiju,** 6 Years Crohn's Disease

Just a few months ago, six-year-old Leraisha was full of energy, but everything changed when she suddenly stopped eating, began vomiting frequently, and rapidly lost weight. Concerned, her parents, Laiju and Aisha, sought answers. After a series of tests, the doctors delivered a heartbreaking diagnosis: Leraisha is suffering from Crohn's Disease, a severe form of inflammatory bowel disease.

Her condition requires continuous treatment with biological injections for the next two years. The cost of her treatment at Rajagiri Hospital, Aluva, Kerala (5.9 km from Aluva Railway Station), is estimated at Rs. 3,00,000 (Rupees Three Lakh Only), an amount that seems impossible for Laiju, a driver, and Aisha, a housewife, to gather. The family, with five members, struggles to make ends meet, but they refuse to give up on their little girl.

With limited means, Laiju has already borrowed money, but it is not enough. Your help could be the lifeline they need. Please, lend a hand and give Leraisha the chance to lead a healthy, happy life. Every contribution, big or small, can make a world of difference.



**18. Arjun S,** 10 Years Heart Disease

According to the doctors at Kerala's Aster Medcity (9.9 km from Kochi Railway Station), Arjun needs to undergo treatment worth Rs.11,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lakh Only).

Arjun's father, Satish works as a conductor and is the sole breadwinner in his family of four. They live in a rented house and have borrowed money from relatives to bear the expense of the treatment.

Baby Feeding Centers (BFCs) are not only a place to help mothers feed their babies, but a movement to make public places accessible to new mothers, exclusively for breastfeeding. The idea behind the Baby Feeding Centre is to provide a haven to nursing mothers and infants. Breastfeeding in public is considered shameful in India and many parts of the world. It also makes the mother uncomfortable while feeding in public, but she does not have any choice due to the lack of options, especially when the child needs milk. These centres are comfortable with cushions and sofas and have a ceiling fan installed.

As of March 2024, Child Help Foundation has established 23 Baby Feeding Centres across various locations. In 2023, these centres were

set up at Urban Health Centre Bandra, Pune Railways Station on August 16, Kashimira Police Station on 21st September in Maharashtra, Sir C. V. Raman General Hospital – 1 and – 2 in Bengaluru, Karnataka on June 19 and 20 respectively, Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee College in Bengaluru, Karnataka on August 5, Institute for Child Health & Hospital for Children in Egmore, Chennai, Tamil Nadu on 7th September, Visakhapatnam Railway Station on October 20 in Andhra Pradesh, and Institute of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Egmore in Chennai, Tamil Nadu on November 7. In 2024, new centres were opened at Krantisinh Nana Patil Civil Hospital in Satara on February 9 and Rural Hospital in Palghar on March 27, both in Maharashtra.

# Visit and Interaction of CHF Trustees to the School Health Program, Palghar, Maharashtra

The meeting included discussions on strategies to overcome challenges faced during the implementation of the program. Rajendra Pathak emphasized the importance of maintaining transparency and accountability in reporting, while Shaji Varghese highlighted the need for ongoing collaboration with local stakeholders to ensure the program's long-term success. The team was encouraged to continue their efforts in reaching the project milestones and enhancing the overall impact of the School Health Program, a program which helps students deal with health-related and social issues.





## **School Health Programme**

#### Vikramgad, Palghar, Maharashtra

CHF conducted health screenings of students in 10 government-run ashram schools in this Taluka that are predominantly tribal. Child Help Foundation has set up a Health Information System (HIS) under this campaign for each school. HIS tracks and monitors the health of the students, particularly those who are more vulnerable, and informs the parents of the students about it. The NGO has also appointed full-time counsellors to identify the more indigent kids prone to suffering from diseases and counsel them and their parents to prevent self-destructive behaviour.

Child Help Foundation also set up awareness sessions on various subjects such as good touch and bad touch, personal hygiene, peer

pressure, sexual and reproductive health, and POSH-POCSO. The volunteers of CHF teach them how to take care of their mental health and give them counselling services at the school level. On the other hand, professional counsellors engage students with different activities by conducting classroom awareness sessions on different social issues and how to tackle them.





## **Wellness Activities**

#### Talwada Ashram School, Palghar, Maharashtra

Talwada Ashram School hosted a largescale yoga workshop, where 1,038 students participated under the guidance of a qualified yoga instructor. The session, organized as part of the wellness activities within the School Health Program, was generously supported by LTPCT (Larsen and Toubro Public Charitable Trust). Students enthusiastically embraced the program, gaining valuable insights into maintaining both physical fitness and mental stability. The workshop not only promoted a healthy lifestyle but also instilled mindfulness and stress-relief techniques, leaving the students eager for more such activities in the future.





# Adolescent Reproductive and Sexual Health (ARSH) Sessions with Students, Palghar, Maharashtra

In addition to health screenings and addressing illness cases, the School Health Program team is working to build students' capacities through interactive awareness sessions on important topics such as peer pressure, hygiene, sexual reproductive health, stress management, anxiety, and study-related challenges. These sessions utilize engaging training tools, including flip charts, posters, banners, and interactive assignments, to ensure effective learning. Conducted by a dedicated team of doctors, nurses, and coordinators, these sessions have already reached over seven thousand students, equipping them with essential knowledge and life skills to navigate their personal and academic lives successfully.







## **Counselling Sessions with Students**

#### Palghar, Maharashtra

In addition to individual counselling, the program also provides health screenings and educational workshops on nutrition, hygiene, and mental health. This comprehensive approach ensures that students receive both preventive care and the necessary tools to maintain a healthy lifestyle that will help them thrive academically and in their future endeavours. Through these initiatives, the School Health Programme fosters a supportive environment that nurtures both the physical and emotional well-being of students in the Vikramgad block of Maharashtra.



## **Awareness session on Mental Health**

#### Palghar, Maharashtra

Under the School Health Programme, the counsellor conducted an awareness session on "Introduction to Mental Health" for 9th and 10th grade students. Despite the prevalence of mental health issues among students in the ashram school, mental health continues to be a neglected area. In response, CHF is placing a strong emphasis on promoting positive mental health by raising awareness on various related topics and offering tailored counselling services to support the students' emotional well-being that can help them navigate problems in both their personal and academic lives.







## **Medical Camp**

#### Mumbai Suburban, Maharashtra

On July 22, 2023, Child Help Foundation joined hands with the Indian Cancer Society, a non-profit organisation specialising in cancer treatment, to organise a medical health camp in Ganesh Deval Nagar Community, Bhayander, Mumbai, Maharashtra.

This is where Arogya Sadan comes in and extends a compassionate hand to underprivileged families from remote regions of India to stay and travel to and fro from Kokilaben Dhirubhai Ambani Hospital and Medical Research Institute to their designated residential premises.

Arogya Sadan not only provides lodging premises for patients in Mumbai but also for patients, their family members and their donors. The lodging also offers services like unwavering support staff 24/7, doctor's

prescribed diet, tuition classes as well as recreational activities, completely living up to the moniker of "Swastha se Shiksha Tak". The project also extends post-transplant care for the patients, along with their donors, because they deserve nothing less than the best.



## **World Cancer Awareness Day**

#### Palghar, Maharashtra

On the occasion of World Cancer Awareness Day, i.e. 9th November, 2023, Child Help Foundation organized awareness sessions in three villages named, Karhe-Talawali, Sakhare and Bhadangepada in Palghar District, Maharashtra. The sessions were conducted by Mr. Ravsaheb, Dr. Preeti and Dr. Sanjeevani, covering the topic of cancer, its reasons, prevention measures and facts. As told by him, the police are making hard efforts to curb the illegal trade and consumption of the drug but are facing hurdles mainly due to a lack of awareness in society.

The session was organised for 9th and 10th standard students from Murbad Ashram School. The session started at 2 pm. There were 133 students present for the session. Ms Jyoti Kamble, Jagannath Khirari and Raju Gangoda were present from CHF.

Mr Jagannath MSC coordinator, welcomed the guest speaker, CHF representatives, teachers and students. The introduction of the program was done by Ms Jyoti Kamble, CHF team member. Then the session started. Ms Patil started the topic of stress management. She used stories and examples. She took one activity where he made the students draw a circle. The students were supposed to write, when

there were exams, they were told to write the things which are not in their control and to write things which are in their control. She asked them to focus on the things which are in their control. She also spoke about the importance of eating nutritious food. The second part of the session was career options. She told them about the streams available after the 10th standard and the career options available.





### **Computer Lab Inauguration**

#### Tailik Girls School, Barbigha, Bihar

There was a significant need for a computer lab at Tailik Girls School in Barbigha, Bihar, as the school had no access to digital resources. Recognizing the importance of providing these girls with modern education and opportunities for digital learning, the CHF (Child Help Foundation), with the support of National Fertilizers Limited, took the initiative to establish a computer lab at the school. The school, which accommodates around 500 girls, was lacking the infrastructure to equip students with necessary technological tools. To address this, a suitable space within the school was identified, and several improvements were made to ensure the lab would be conducive to learning. The room was freshly painted to create a bright and welcoming environment, and a carpet was installed to make the space more comfortable. Additionally, essential furniture, such as desks, chairs, and shelves, was provided to organize the lab and create an efficient working environment. A key component of this initiative was the appointment of a computer teacher, who was responsible for guiding the students through the basics of computer usage, programming, and other aspects of digital literacy. With a skilled educator in place, the lab became a center for learning not only academic subjects but also vital skills such as typing, internet usage, and familiarity with office software, which are essential in today's digital world. This computer lab is a game-changer for the girls at Tailik Girls School. It not only helps them academically by supplementing their studies with digital resources but also equips them with essential digital literacy skills. In a world that is increasingly reliant on technology, these

skills are vital for their personal and professional development, opening doors to future educational opportunities, jobs, and personal empowerment. Through the efforts of CHF and the generous support of National Fertilizers Limited, the girls of Tailik Girls School now have access to the tools they need to succeed in the modern world.









### **Mini Science Centre Lessons**

### M S Maur and M S Koyaribigha School, Barbigha, Bihar

Two Mini Science Centres (MSC) were established at MS Maur and MS Koyaribigha Schools, supported by National Fertilizers Limited. In September, the MSC coordinator conducted training sessions for students on topics such as Nutrition, Health & Cleanliness, POCSO, Waterborne Diseases, and Career Guidance. Additionally, she trained teachers on POSH and POCSO. Following this training, she conducted classes using Science and Mathematics models, teaching ten different models over the course of ten sessions to students from 5th to 10th grade. The students have shown great enthusiasm for learning, eagerly attending these engaging classes.
















### **GENDER EQUALITY**

### **CLEAN WATER AND SANITATION**

Diseases are rampant in areas where cleanliness is still a dream. For a healthy society, the surroundings must be clean. Child Help Foundation wants everyone to enjoy clean amenities.

Toilets have reached 2,294 more people and 5,314 people got access to clean drinking water in the year 2023-24. Sanitary napkins were also distributed to 5,013 girls to promote menstrual hygiene.



Child Help Foundation is spreading awareness among school girls by distributing sanitary napkins to the school girls. It is very important to create awareness among students as there are many beliefs as well as taboos among school girls volunteers of Child Help Foundation, Odisha. On 5th May, distributed sanitary pads to 106 school students from 6th to 10th standard. These pads will make it easier for them to stay focused on school while menstruating, leading to improve academic performance and also maintaining menstrual hygiene at the same time.













# **Village Cleaning**

### Sahapur, Odisha

Every Sunday in the month of September, Village cleaning activity was done by the 10-15 volunteers of Hemchandra Sanskrit Vidyalaya at Sahapur, Odisha. # **Deep Cleaning Drive**


#### Mumbai Suburban, Maharashtra

Children from the age group of 3 years to 14 years received the snacks. The mothers expressed their thanks for distributing snacks to their children as the community belongs to a low economic background.







## **Essential Distribution at Old Age Home**

On January 5, 2024, CHF distributed approximately 100 blankets, 100 pairs of slippers, 100 woolen caps, and 50 adult diapers to SHEOMS, an old-age home in Okhla, New Delhi. All items were generously donated by a corporation in Gurugram as part of our winter drive initiative.







# **Relief Camp**

#### **Manipur**

Child Help Foundation partnered with India Cares to provide critical assistance in Manipur. Five relief camps—Phubala High School, Thangalawai Awang Leikai, Moirangkhunou Mamang Sabal Santi Club, Moirangkhunou Mayai Leikai Seva Club, and Moirangkhunou Makha Leikai Mandop received essential medical kits and supplies through India Cares' dedicated efforts. This joint initiative aims to support displaced and vulnerable communities by addressing their immediate healthcare needs during these challenging times and ensuring timely access to essential medical services and resources.







## **Ration Distribution at Caring Hands**

### Ahilya Nagar, Maharashtra

The Caring Hands organization originally began its work with children of migrant workers in Ahilya Nagar. However, challenges brought on by the COVID - 19 pandemic forced the closure of their Ahilya Nagar centre. In response, the children were relocated to a newly established facility called Seva Kutir in Mira Bhayandar, housed in a 21,000-square-foot space donated by Smt. Jayashree Date.

Seva Kutir, located in Uttan Bhayandar, has been operational for the past seven months and serves as a home for adolescent boys. The centre continues Caring Hands' mission to support marginalized children, including those from migrant families. Currently, Seva Kutir cares for 21 boys—9 relocated from Ahilya Nagar and 12 enrolled from the local area. Some of the children are orphans,

while others come from families facing financial hardship or unstable home environments, often due to issues like alcoholism.

The children at Seva Kutir are provided with three nutritious meals a day, incorporating local vegetables and fish to ensure balanced nutrition. To help sustain these meals, Child Help Foundation (CHF) stepped in to provide essential rations. On March 20, 2024, a CHF team visited the centre to deliver rice, pulses, flour, and other staples sufficient to last for one month. This contribution ensures the continued well-being of the boys, supporting their health and nutrition during their time at the centre.







### LIFE BELOW WATER

Beaches have lost their pristine beauty because of human activity. Instead of sand, one can find heaps of trash. With the help of corporations, other NGOs and volunteers, Child Help Foundation has conducted numerous beach clean-ups. We hope that our efforts will inspire others to rise and fight for these innocent animals, and in turn, create a safe environment for these voiceless swimmers.

Through these beach clean-ups, Child Help Foundation has picked up 928 kilograms of trash and saved 27,840 marine animals. We hope that our efforts will inspire others to rise and fight for these innocent animals, and in turn, create a safe environment for these voiceless swimmers.

- Volunteers are provided with gloves, trashbags, and other safety equipment.
- In the 2023-2024 period, CHF collected 928 kg of waste.

#### **Impact:**

 The clean-up benefited 27,840 marine species, contributing to healthier coastal ecosystems.



### **LIFE ON LAND**

Our voiceless companions lay out their silent cries in distress due to human activities. Child Help Foundation tries its best to soothe their pain by conducting plantation and feeding drives. These activities not only provide comfort to animals but also give the volunteers a moment of joy and warmth.

Child Help Foundation has saved 2,554 trees and animals during this year.

### Tree Plantation Drive, Haryana

A tree plantation drive was held with Shri Swapnil Ravindra Patil, IAS, Additional Deputy Commissioner of Rewari, Haryana. This initiative, part of a broader campaign in partnership with the Rural Development Agency, aimed to enhance the village's environment.

The village sarpanch, Monika Yadav, along with local residents, NCC school members, and scout children, actively participated in this effort, marking a significant step towards maintaining and nourishing the rural ecosystem.

The event aimed to educate children about the harmful effects of plastic on Mother Earth and promote the reduction of plastic usage. During the session, Ms. Lopes facilitated engaging discussions and activities that highlighted the environmental challenges posed by single-use plastics, helping the children understand the urgent need for change. In addition, items received on "Give Away Something Day" were distributed to the children, further encouraging sustainable practices. The children were actively engaged in learning how small changes in their daily habits could make a significant impact. By nurturing this awareness, Child Help Foundation continues to empower the next generation to take meaningful action for a healthier planet.











### **DAAN UTSAV 2023-24**

Child Help Foundation (CHF), a pan-India, non-profit organization organized the Daan Utsav Activity for a week in October 2023. Daan Utsav is celebrated every year from the 2nd to the 8th of October. It is India's biggest festival of 'Giving' during which people come together and perform acts of kindness by donating their time, belongings or money in various ways.

This initiative of Daan Utsav by Child Help Foundation was planned in various cities across India like Mumbai, Haryana, Kerala, Visakhapatnam, and Kolkata. in the first week of October '23.

Under Daan Utsav's initiative, the volunteers of the NGO distributed notebooks, t-shirts, baby sacks, and nutrition kits, fed animals, served tuberculosis patients and distributed blankets.
















## FOUNDATION DAY 13TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

# **Child for Child Program**

Child for Child Programme raises funds for schools throughout India to conduct operations of Child Help Foundation. These are the details of the programme:

#### Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh

In Visakhapatnam, Child Help Foundation successfully conducted a fundraising initiative focused on "Emergency Medical Support and Education," reaching 3,301 students across eight schools. The funds will ensure that quality education and healthcare reaches underprivileged children.

#### Kolkata, West Bengal

The Kolkata team organized awareness sessions in privileged schools under the "Child for Child" initiative, encouraging students to understand and support their less privileged peers by raising funds for their education and needs. These funds will be extremely beneficial to the underprivileged students in the region.





# Areas Covered in the Eastern Region (2023–24)
