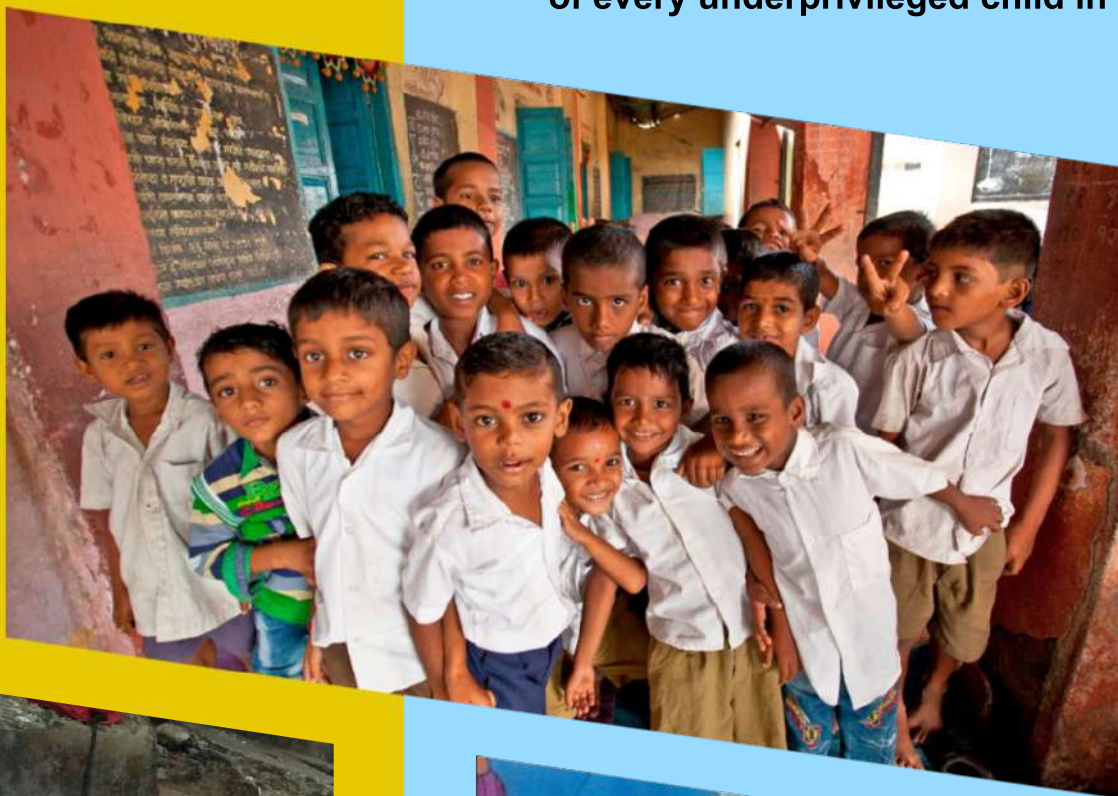

By 2019, we hope to raise funds for at least 100 underprivileged children in urgent need of Heart Surgery and 500 underprivileged children who need urgent cancer treatment.



Swastha Se Shiksha Programme

Emergency medical cases of children that are referred to us are taken up for medical support on a case-to-case basis, depending on financial condition of parents or guardians and criticality of the patient. Many of these children, especially those afflicted by cancer, take many months and sometimes even years to recover; during this treatment phase many of them are unable to attend school.

Due to the extended periods of absence from school and the lack of motivation or financial backing many of them end up as dropouts. Through our intervention we ensure that once they recover, they are counselled and encouraged to return to school. In addition, their school admission is secured in our affiliate schools and their education is sponsored with the help of our corporate partners. This ensures that their future prospects do not suffer and they can be successfully integrated with mainstream society.

Objectives of the “Swastha Se Shiksha” Programme:

- Ensuring that young patients who have recovered do not end up as dropouts.
- Motivating the cured patient to return to schooling.
- Ensuring that they gain admittance in our partner schools.
- Providing counseling and vocational training.
- Sponsoring the fees of children from BPL families, who cannot afford to educate their children.
- Providing school stationery, bags, shoes, uniforms, books etc.
- Empowering the families of underprivileged children.



Orphanage Support Programme:

Through our Orphanage Support Programme, Child Help Foundation's goal is to provide care and assistance to those children who have lost their parents' love and support, allowing them to blossom and receive holistic education. Children need consistent and comprehensive care and support to grow and prosper. Child Help Foundation's Orphanage Support Programme provides orphaned children with hope, love and prospects for the future.
